1. Cotman Water Colours or similar. They usually come in a box of twelve half-pan colours. Do not get tubes of paint as they are not practical and do not last as long. Daler watercolours are fine but not as good as Winsor & Newton, Cotman Watercolours



2. An A3 Book of good quality Watercolour Paper. (Cheap paper will not give you the best results and this can be frustrating.)
3. A Cotman or similar make, size 2, 4, 5 and 8 paint brush, a reasonably good quality brush will last much longer than a cheap one

Two small jam jars, a roll of tissue paper

Optional: A tube of indigo, Cadmium Orange and Sepia.
